SHAPES:

- Slot boards: Platform nose, concave bottom, twin fin, 7 reported made. 1948. 1949
- Note: Nose similar to Star Ship Enterprise bridge, with slots on each rail distinguishing nose from board.

RAILS:

- 50/50. 1945. 1949
- 60/40 to 80/20. 1949. 1953

GLASSING:

- Gel coat only. 1945. 1948
- With cloth. 1948. 1953

FINS: Twin. 1953. 1953
