FACTORY: Seaside, Oregon. started 1972 closed 1973

MODELS: None. All these boards were custom made. 1972 1973

BLANKS: Clark foam. 1972 1973

STRINGERS: Spruce. 1972 1973

NOSE & TAIL BLOCKS: Mainly wood on some long boards. 1972 1973

SHAPES: All custom 1972. 1973

LOGO: Silhouette of a large evergreen tree. 1972 1973

Note: Boards with handwritten 'Evergreen' across the stringer are not from this line of boards.

GLASSING:

Silene: Free lap except for cut lap on resin pigments 1972 1973

Volan: Rarely used. 1972 1973

RESIN: Ortho, or others upon custom requests. 1972 1973

FINS: Glass-on, mostly solid glass, made in house. 1972 1973

COLOR: Primarily pigment panels, some air brushing. 1972 1973

FINISH: Glossed & polished or sanded. 1972 1973

NUMBERING: None. Some may have had the customers name.

PRODUCTION: Less than 300 made.
