“Classic”, limited edition of 7, numbered ‘1 of 7’ to ‘7 of 7’ s 2000. x 2000
3 stringers, double 6oz deck & bottom with 4oz deck patch, single box, & hand written logo.

All “Classic” models carry both the San Diego Surf Shop logo, **Figure 1** and the Glen Horn logo, **Figure 2**

GLASSING:

Deck: 6 oz + 5 oz + 4 oz ¾ patch. 1966. 2011

Bottom: 5 oz or 6 oz. 1966. 2011

RESIN: Silmar 249-A. 1966. 2011

FINS:

Unlimited, center. 1966. 2011

Figgie. 1998. 2011

Teak Gillette laminated side fins, exotic wood from around the world. 1997. 2008

Only about 20 sets will be used.

NUMBERING: [Reliability = 9]

Glen Horn boards were not numbered until 1989.

Random numbering. 1989. 1992

Sequential numbering was started in 1993. Around ten numbers were duplicated and may have an “A” or “B” to differentiate. Between 1993 and 1995 some custom numbers with the year were used, ie: “1994-1”

1,031 to 3,063. 1993. 1995

3,064 to 3,378 (3,337 to 3,353 not used, and about 100 of 1999 numbers re-used in 2000). 1996. 2000

3,379 to 3,794 2001. 2005

3,795 to 3,940. 2006. 2010

3, 941 and up. 2011. 2011
