COLOR (no artwork): Tints, painted foam or hot coat, opaque glosses, pinlines. 1975..... 1982

GLASSING:

Note: The original Graphlite sample board was a 7'6" pintail. It was laminated with a single 5 oz flat weave Kevlar with 2" carbon fiber center strips and then covered with a single 1 oz layer. It was finished with linear polyurethane Interlux yacht paint.

Normal glassing with a carbon fiber band and stringer.....	1975.....	1982

Vinyl ester resin with rubber compounds (highly toxic).....	1975.....	1976

FINISH: Sanded. 1975..... 1982
