Note: All Sculptures were hand drawn without the use of templates, also called “free hand shaping”.

“White Star” Hand written on foam. Single or twin, “Porche of surfboards”. s 1970. x 1971

BLANKS: Clark foam, no balsa or other wood blanks or nose/tail blocks..... 1969. 1971

Ed Shumpert (Sculpting works can be seen in Huntington Beach, Ca). 1969. 1970

Pat Cosgrove (Shaped the “White Star” series). 1970. 1971

SHAPES: Transitional with turned down rails..... 1969. 1971

RESIN: Isophthalic. 1969. 1971

FINISH: All were glossed & polished. 1969. 1971

FINS: Unlimited only, single or twin. 1969. 1971

NUMBERING: [Reliability = 8] These boards were sequentially numbered with less than 150 made.
