LOGO: ‘Rocky Point - Surfboards’ **Figure 1**. s 1986. x 1989

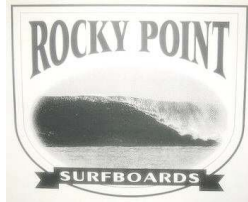

6 oz + 4 oz deck, 6 oz or 4 oz bottom. 1986. 1988
E-cloth, some S-cloth, Hexel, Trevano or JP Stevens. 1986. 1988
Silmar 249-A or Ortho/Iso blend. 1986. 1988

COLOR & ART: Airbrushing, tints, opaques, foam stains, pin lines and abstracts. 1986. 1988

FINS: Glass-ons or Unlimited for single or 2+1's. 1986. 1988

FINISH: Glossed and polished or speed coat. 1986. 1988

NUMBERING: Signed with dimensions on bottom, some may have a number. 1986. 1988

PRODUCTION: No more than 100 made total.
